



GET REPORTING-READY for your CWDG Annual Grant Performance Reporting

All CWDG Annual Accomplishments must be reported using the new [Fire Adapted Communities Accomplishments Reporting Module \(ARM\)](#) starting with the 2024 Performance Reporting period. The reporting window opens in January 2025, and all reports must be submitted no later than March 31, 2025 (NOTE: *If filing a Final Performance Report, the window may be extended to April 30, 2025*).

HOW TO PREPARE

NOW → REVIEW the reporting requirements

- Go to the ARM Reporting Guidance page [HERE](#)
- Open & review the Quantitative Accomplishments Business Rules
- Open & review the Mapping Guidance (fuels treatments and CWPP boundaries)
- Start tracking, quantifying, and if applicable, mapping your accomplishments

DECEMBER (onwards) → LEARN how to use the ARM to enter your accomplishments details for your Annual Performance Report

- Online training will be available on demand starting in December
- A User Guide will also be available for step-by-step instructions

JANUARY → RECEIVE an email from your Grant Administrator

- This email will be sent to the Grant Contact that the Grant Administrator has for your grant
- The email will contain a private link to your grant profile page and will be where you can enter the details for your Performance Report

JANUARY to MARCH → REPORT your accomplishments

- Enter the quantitative, mapped and narrative accomplishments into the Performance Report
- Review, print, and when your details are ready, SUBMIT the report
- Your Grant Administrator will review and approve the report if there are no issues; otherwise, you will be notified by them about any changes they are requesting
