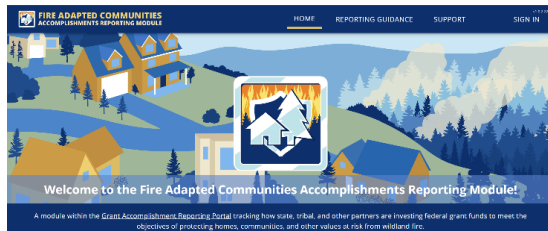




CWDG Annual Grant Performance Reporting USER GUIDES AND eLEARNING COURSES ARE NOW AVAILABLE



If you and your community are a recipient of a Community Wildfire Defense Grant, your Annual Performance Reports for CWDG Grants must be submitted using the new [Fire Adapted Communities Accomplishments Reporting Module](#) (“Community ARM”) starting January 2025. Remember that 2024 reports are due no later than March 31, 2025; *extensions can be requested to April 30 if filing a final report.*

Important: CWDG Awardees will **not need Community ARM accounts** to submit Performance Reports; Grant Administrators will be sending access links to each grantee separately.
